On September 3, 2021, South Texas Training Center signed and returned to the Department the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) III American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP) Certification Form (ARP (a)(4) ALN 84.425Q Supplemental Agreement) required to receive supplemental funds allocated under The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (P.L. 117-2). The institution has used or intends to use the total funds received to provide emergency financial aid grants to students.
2. The total amount of funds that the institution has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement specifically for emergency financial aid grants to students is as follows: HEERF III: \$114,720
3. The total amount of emergency financial aid grants distributed to students under Section 314(d)(7) of the CRRSAA and the supplemental HEERF III award as of the date of this Fund Report is: \$59,800
4. The estimated total number of students at the institution eligible to participate in programs and thus potentially qualified to receive emergency financial aid grants under Section 314(d)(7) of the CRRSAA and the supplemental HEERF III award, as of the date of this Fund Report is: 600
5. As of this date South Texas Training Center has established the following eligibility requirements: Must be or have been enrolled at South Texas Training Center on or after March 13, 2020. Eligible students with exceptional need (as defined below) are eligible to receive grants of up to \$500. All other eligible students are eligible to receive grants of up to \$200. In accordance with issued guidance, South Texas Training defines "students with exceptional need" as: Makes a household income of \$15,000 or less.
6. As of this date all eligible students have been notified via email with instructions on how to contact the school to learn about their options to receive the emergency grant in addition to announcements posted throughout the campus. Once a student contacts the school, we explain the application process and how they can choose to apply funds to their existing account balances, or have the grant sent to them directly.
